**Sun hat, sunscreen, gloves and sturdy shoes are required, please.**

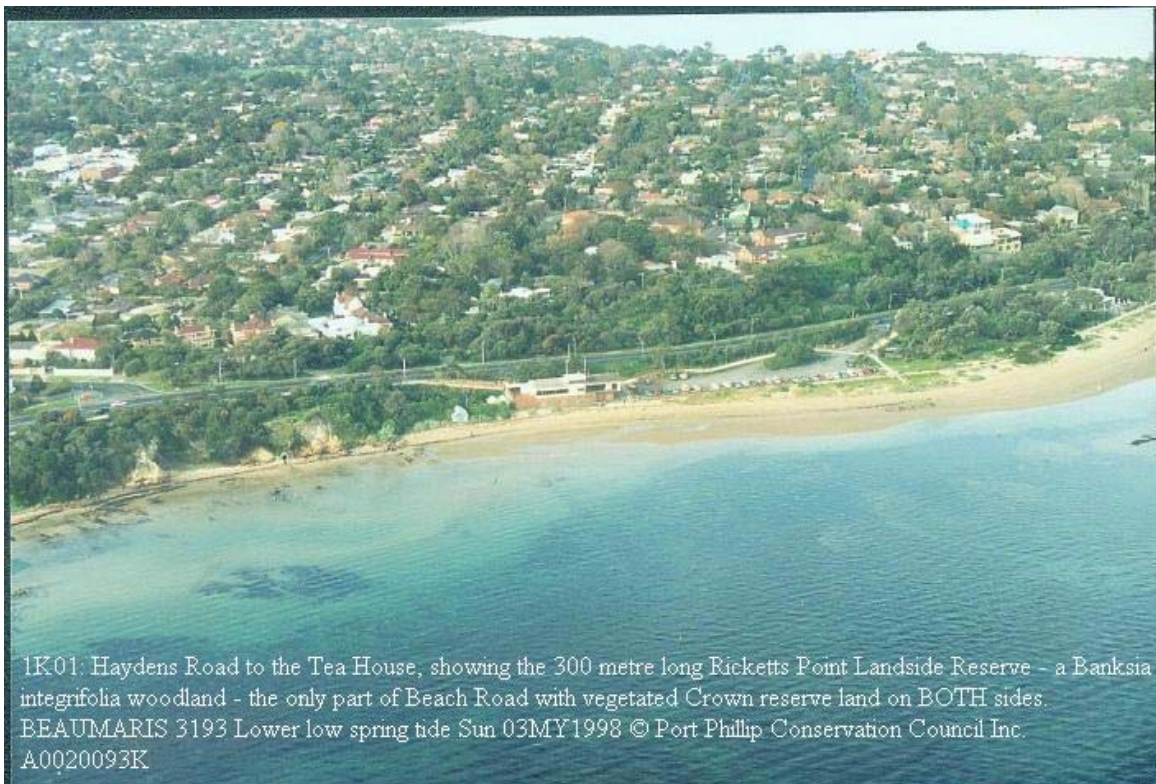
