



Beaumaris Bay, September 2009: BCS Inc. opposes a \$21 million bid by Beaumaris Motor Yacht Squadron Ltd, whose leased filled land appears at left, for a marina to store 120 power boats that would replace the present 60-metre long concrete pier above with a pair of rock walls extending out from the already filled land 160 metres into Beaumaris Bay.

The total length of rock wall would be 550 metres and it would cover 12,000 square metres of seabed. In addition to that filling on the seabed, a further net increase of 3,000 square metres of filled land is sought. The plans also seek a three-level dry boat stack for 78 power boats as high as the Cliff, for a length of 88 metres along it. All for a private club!
